We undertake that the arms/ammunition above will not be resold, transferred and/or disposed of without prior notice to and approval from the Director-General of Trade and Industry. We understand that failure to do so may render the above licence be cancelled, revoked or suspended in addition to other appropriate legal and/or administrative actions to be taken against the entities concerned.

Important Note :

If the end-user **and** end-use remain consistent with the information stated on the issued import licence and the concerned importer-cum-end-user statement, licensees are not required to make application and prior approval by Trade and Department is not necessary for the intended resale / transfer.

The approval of this application is subject to (a) the terms and the conditions of the relevant foreign export authorisation (i.e. the foreign export authorisation listed on the import licence issued); and (b) the validity and conditions of the possession or dealer's licence issued by the Hong Kong Police Force under the Firearms and Ammunition Ordinance (Cap.238, Laws of Hong Kong). The licensee and end-user shall inform the Trade and Industry Department in case there is any change to the terms and conditions on the possession or dealer's licence, or in case the possession or dealer's licence is cancelled, invalidated, or revoked by the Hong Kong Police Force.

Even if this application for resale / transfer / disposal of arms or ammunition under approved import licence is approved by the Director-General of the Trade and Industry, the licensee and end-user are still required to notify the Hong Kong Police Force in accordance with the Firearms and Ammunition Ordinance (Cap. 238, Laws of Hong Kong).

The data collected in this form will be kept in confidence. They may however be disclosed to other government departments, or to third parties in Hong Kong or elsewhere, if such disclosure is necessary to facilitate consideration of the related application, is in the public interest, is authorised or required by the law; or if explicit consent to such disclosure is given by the applicant/data subject.
